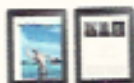

The National Open Art Competition: call for entry

The 15th edition of the National Open Art Competition (NOAC) is now open for submission. This annual contest has run since 1996 and is organised by the Chichester Art Trust, a British not-for-profit charity. Catherine Lampert, former director of the Whitechapel Gallery, said: "For some this exhibition is the moment an artist's career really takes off". Emerging artists as well as professional artists are free to send in their work.

The NOAC offer an open platform where UK artists can exhibit and sell their work to a large audience and additionally give away a Prize Fund of £40 000. Artists who work in the field of drawings, paintings, photographs, street art, computer generated art or wall hung installations can enter up to six of their best pieces.

The jury of the 2012 edition is chaired by Lisa Wright and supported by Francis Hodgson, Andrew Stahl, Gus Casely-Hayford and Cedar Lewisohn. Deadline for submission is 31 July 2012.
